Evaluation of enhanced models of primary care in the management of stroke and other chronic diseases: the PRECISE project

Funded models of enhanced primary care may improve the quality of care for people living with stroke through more comprehensive secondary prevention and disability management.

The purpose of the PRECISE project is to assess the effectiveness of these models of care, by conducting a population-based linked cohort study (N= ~30,000).

We are seeking workshop participants to assist with:

- Reviewing our comparative (and cost) effectiveness analyses from a consumer, clinician and/or policy-maker perspective
- Interpreting the results against a range of implementation and other policy considerations
- Developing recommendations for implementation into policy and practice
