The Department of Health and Aged Care (the Department) have engaged KPMG to undertake a rapid retrospective effectiveness review of the existing General Practice Incentive Programs.

This includes the Practice Incentive Program (PIP), and Workforce Incentives Program (WIP).

This review will draw on qualitative and quantitative evidence to evaluate the effectiveness of general practice incentives and will be an input into future policy considerations.
