

PRODA and HPOS

Provider Digital Access (PRODA)

Provider Digital Access is an online identity verification and authentication system to securely access online Government services.

PRODA account will never expire and will move with you across roles or organisations. You can create only one PRODA account in your name. Hence use your own personal email ID as well as personal mobile to register.

You will need 100 points identification.

- Australian driver licence
- Medicare card
- Australian passport or foreign passport

(If you have changed your name and your name differs across the documents, you will also need a change of name certificate or an official marriage certificate)

Health Professional Online Service (HPOS)

Health Professional Online Service (HPOS) is a secure way to do business with Services Australia. One can access HPOS as an individual or access it on behalf of an Organisation via their personal PRODA Account. HPOS is available to all Health Professionals.

Link your healthcare identifiers such as AHPRA number, HPI-I number, Medicare Provider number, PBS approved prescriber numbers to your PRODA account so you can access HPOS functions.
