The IAR-DST can assist users to:

- Explore essential information during a mental health assessment and review critical and holistic information that is essential for decision making.
- Estimate or confirm the mental health treatment needs of the patient or consumer.
- Communicate treatment needs with others in the sector, reducing the frustration that might occur when referring to mental health services.
