Emergency Response Planning Tool (ERPT) subscription

Expression of interest for general practices

In supporting general practices to strengthen their disaster preparedness, Northern Queensland Primary Health Network (NQPHN) is offering a two-year subscription to the Emergency Response Planning Tool (ERPT) for each practice across the NQPHN region.

What is the ERPT?

The ERPT is a cloud-based, practical online tool designed to help general practices be better prepared for, respond to, and recover from the impacts of emergencies and pandemics.

The tool guides users through a series of planning templates where critical information about the practice can be entered and saved. The information is used to create an emergency response plan which is individually tailored to the general practice. The customised plan is then saved and stored in the cloud and can also be printed as a hard copy resource at any time.

The ERPT is continually updated with new modules to address emerging risks and necessary business practice changes.

HOW IT WORKS

Once approved, the practice (one per practice) will purchase the two-year subscription at a cost of \$800.00 (ex. GST). NQPHN will fully reimburse practices upon the receipt of their ERPT receipt and tax invoice.

Only a limited number of funded licenses are available. Interested practices must submit an expression of interest via the online link. Healthpoint ANZ will assist in the registration process and will contact your practice directly.
